

# **The Patty Baucom Scholarship**

The Woman of Siler have given scholarships to students from Siler for the past 24 years. In 1988 the scholarship was first conceived and distributed.

The Scholarship is now named in memory of Patty Baucom, a wife, mother of two and teacher of DECA at Parkwood High School, and active member of Siler Presbyterian Church. Patty was the first chairperson of the Presbyterian Women Scholarship Committee. Patty was in the process of acquiring a second degree from Winthrop university when she died. Education was something she strongly believed in, and we trust that this scholarship honors her.

Since 1988, 117 Awards have been made to 53 students, many students being awarded the scholarship for multiple years. The Scholarship fund has been generously supported by individual donations as well as Woman of Siler fund raising efforts. It is our great hope that this scholarship will continue to help future Siler Students for many years to come.
