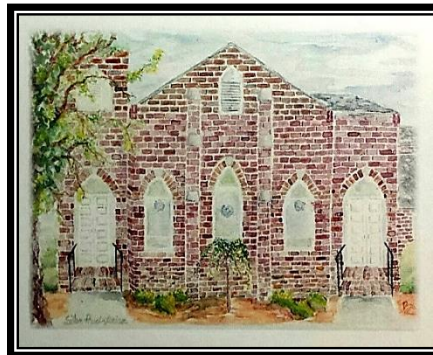

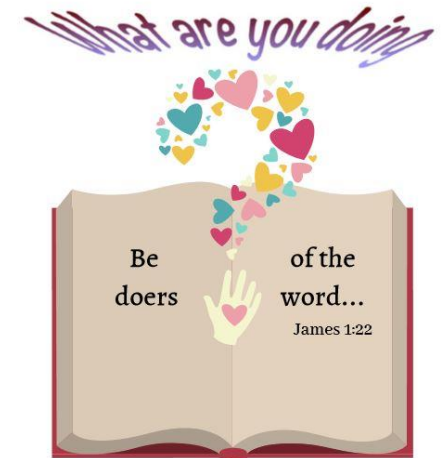

Susan Moore

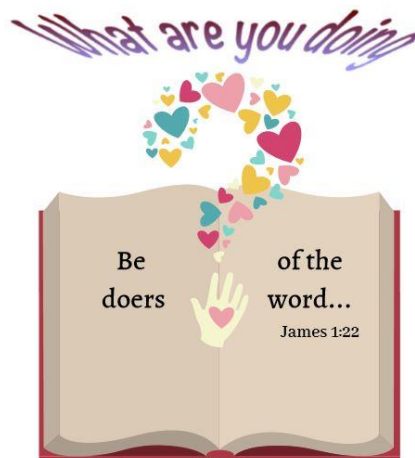
SUSAN MOORE
